Qualifications and Requirements

Who Can Apply?

1. Anyone who is currently in the 6th through 11th grades.
2. Applicants must also be active in their local church and be recommended by their pastor.

What is involved?

1. Attendance requirements and meeting schedules vary from district to district, but membership on all district youth councils is a commitment of personal time and leadership. Members are expected to attend all DCOYM meetings and programs. In addition, six youth from each district will be elected to serve on the Conference Council on Youth Ministries (CCOYM), which meets four times per year. Elected OFFICERS at the District and Conference level must be confirmed members of their local churches.
2. The year begins with participation in **Youth Assembly**, a mandatory, weeklong leadership training and team-building camp June 27th – July 3rd, 2010 at Camp Wesley Woods in Dowling, MI. The cost per camper is minus any costs that may be paid by your district youth council (these vary from district to district.)

Scholarship money may also be available through your local church, and it is our goal to make this week of camp affordable to any qualified district youth council member. (*This fee reflects $\frac{3}{4}$ of the total camper fee of \$325. The Conference Council on Youth Ministries offsets $\frac{1}{4}$ of the cost of this camp as part of their commitment to youth leadership training in our Conference. In other words the amount that the individual camper/district is responsible for is \$243.75.)

3. As a member of DCOYM you will be a representative of the District Council. Some responsibilities of this representation are contacting churches in your area, assisting in the planning and implementation of district events, and presenting a positive image for the district youth council and youth in ministry in your church and community. **This would include your responsibilities in academics, sports, and other school activities.** As a member of the council you may also be responsible for contacting other council members for information on events or meeting details.
4. Members 16 and older are required to be certified under the West Michigan Conference Abuse Prevention Training standards (we will help you fulfill this requirement).
