From 1996-2004 Bishop Rader was elected and served as secretary for our denomination's Council of Bishops, and currently serves as the ecumenical officer and occasional head of communion. Bishop Rader, a frequent speaker on issues of leadership in the church, will challenge us with a keynote entitled, "To Be or Not to Be—That is the Question!"
